Outline

This course will provide opportunities to work alongside another Early Year's setting to review and support inclusive practice.

On completion of the final session, each participant will have developed a bank of planning resources, strategies and approaches and assessment tools for all areas of SEND within the Code of Practice.

Course content will cover a multitude of areas to support children with SEN in Early Years settings compromising of; The Graduated Approach including identification of need and signposts for support, Communication and Interaction including development, assessment and interaction, Cognition and Learning including development and assessment of typical play and thinking skills, Social, Emotional and Mental Health including emotional development and regulation, Physical and Sensory including how development in this area may differ for children with SEN. The final session focusses on Transition and Celebration which includes showcasing good practice plus strategies to support effective transitions.
