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Practical Strategies and Support for children in the Early Years with SEND - For Support Staff

This course sets out to support practitioners in identifying children with SEND in their Early Years settings as well as demonstrating a range of strategies to ensure an inclusive environment in which children are able to thrive.

It will focus on:

- Knowledge and understanding of SEND in the Early Years sector.
- Identifying and adapting the environment
- Understanding behaviour is communication and how to implement de-escalation strategies to support children with SEND
- Recognising the significance and development of communication and interaction in Early Years.
- Provide strategies to support children in developing communication and interaction skills.
- A range of visual supports and how to embed these.
- How to build and maintain positive relationships.
- Assessment tools to plan and implement high quality interventions and supportive strategies.

Attendees will have tasks to carry out in their setting between the two sessions. This is to help embed practice.

Practical Classroom Strategies and Support for pupils with Cognition and Learning Difficulties – For Support Staff

This will be a practical, hands on training workshop to share strategies to use in the classroom to support pupils in accessing learning. It will focus on:

- Organisation
- readiness to learn
- memory
- understanding language
- fine-motor skills
- literacy
- maths difficulties.

- To introduce the main areas of difference in autism.

- To develop your knowledge, understanding and skills of supporting individuals with communication and interaction differences.
- To learn practical skills and strategies that can be used to support pupils with communication and interaction differences.

Practical Strategies and Support for children with Social Emotional Mental Health needs – For Support Staff

- To develop Practitioners knowledge and understanding of Social, Emotional, & Mental Health and to feel confident to use this knowledge to support individuals with SEMH need in the Primary and Secondary Settings.
- To consider the whole school environment and to Identify and adapt the setting to improve outcomes for all pupils
- To understand that all behaviour is communication and to consider strategies such as Emotional Coaching and Co-regulation as a way of supporting pupils to understand their own emotions and the ways in which they can manage these
- To explore de-escalation strategies and to understand how using them will deliver better outcomes for pupils with SEND/SEMH
- To introduce different practical ideas and strategies that will help to support pupils with SEMH needs within their own setting
- To understand the importance and impact of consistency, routines and boundaries and to ensure they are embedded in their everyday school life
- To explore a range of visual support tools and interventions such as Meet & Greet, Small Group Work,
 Friendship Groups
