

Education and Training for Primary Schools





Nursery/Reception

Teddy Takes a Tumble – Story Sack Session

Small Groups in the classroom 20 to 25 minutes

Key Messages – Seat belt wearing and child restraints.

Role Play Session

Whole Class in the School hall 30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages - Holding hands, stop, look, listen, think, using the lollipop person.

Year 1 and Year 2

Role Play Session

School hall

30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages – Holding hands, stop, look, listen, think, using the lollipop person and safer places to cross.

Mrs Armitage On Wheels - Interactive Story Session

Classroom

20 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages - Crossing the road safely, be bright be seen and cycling safely.

Year 3

Pedestrian Training - Practical on road skills

15 Children (half a class) outside school.

45 minute sessions x 2 plus a classroom session beforehand.

Schools will need to provide at least one adult to help. This can be a member of staff or a parent volunteer.

Key Messages -Safer places to cross, parked cars and junctions.

Year 3 and Year 4

Role Play Session

'It's your choice'

School hall

30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages – Safer places to cross, becoming an independent road user and the Green Cross Code.

In Car Safety Session

School hall

30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages – Seat belt wearing, car seats and dangers of distracting the driver.

Year 5 and Year 6

Cycling Training

Off road skills based training for Year 5 and 6.

Schools are asked to provide the trainers, who may be teachers, parents, governors or volunteers.

The Road Safety Team will provide training and ongoing support for all instructors.

Charlie's Accident

School hall

30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages - Pedestrian accidents, distractions, consequences of the accident.
Who's to blame and who is affected.

In Car Safety Session

School hall

30 minutes (approximately)

Key Messages – Seat belt wearing, car seats and dangers of distracting the driver.

Parent/Carer Sessions



We are able to offer advice and information sessions to parents.
