Beginning /j/			
			
Use <b>g</b> before e, i and y (except for the syllable ject e.g. subject)		Use <b>j</b> everywhere else

Ending /j/			
Use <b>dge</b> at th end of one syllable words straight after a short vowel		Use <b>ge</b> everywhere else	

Tip!

English words never end in /j/.

Words of two or more syllables ending in /ij/ are spelt <b>age</b>
