

SIMULTANEOUS ORAL SPELLING (SOS) METHOD

<p>1. Adult writes the word – adult and child say the letter names and the word. The child traces over the letters with their finger saying the letter names and then the word.</p>	<p>2. Child can copy the word saying each letter as they write it and then says the word. The child writes over the word using a crayon or felt tip. Trace over in different colours creating a rainbow word– saying the letters as they write and then the word.</p>
<p>3. Cover the 2 boxes above can the child spell the word correctly? – If not look where they are going wrong and help them to think of a strategy to help. Practise again.</p>	<p>4. Ask the child to write the word with their eyes closed.</p>
