It is best to make a tricky word spelling card for laugh and teach as an exception word.

As 'ough' has a number of different sounds and there are only a few words for each, teach 'ough' as a set of irregular words for reading and spelling. Below are examples of tricky/irregular word cards you could make for 'ough'.
