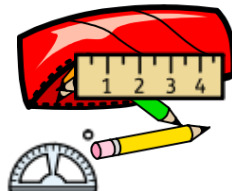
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## Equipment I will Need



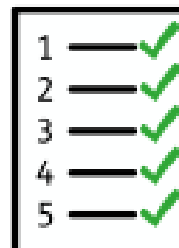

You will find that your secondary school will have a lot more going on after school. Find out the sports and clubs which are available and try something new!



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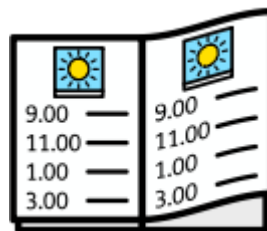
## Homework
