

How to support communication development by reducing questioning.

Why?

- This is to support children to develop vocabulary and communication.
- Research shows that reducing questioning can help a child to develop their spoken communication. By restricting the number of questions you ask a child, you are reducing the expectations and pressure to produce an answer.
- The Elklan hand model is a good way to adapt the language used by practitioners. It replaces questions with modelling language.

Comment	scooter	you like the scooter
Repetition	big van	big van
Expansion	banana	yum, yellow banana
Explanation	I'm happy	happy playing in the water
