

Total Pupil Absence - Autumn/Spring 2016-17 to 2021-22











Persistent Absence %







Severe Absence Percentage

Severe Absence is a relatively new measure, giving a percentage of the pupil population who have attended school for less than 50% of the time. Our rates in Bradford are growing at a higher rate than regionally and nationally, and are at a significantly higher level.

This is concerning given that these pupils will be the most vulnerable and will probably require more complex, intensive interventions to meet various needs, usually requiring Childrens Social Care.




Primary Severe Absence - Autumn/Spring 2016-17 to 2021-22

Whilst Severe Absence in Primary Schools is on a downwards trajectory, it is still significantly higher than the rates seen regionally and nationally.




Secondary Schools are the major contributor to Bradford's increased levels of Severe Absence, standing at 4.41%. This equates to 1661 pupils, all of whom will require significant, costly intervention in order to improve attendance to above 90%.

Secondary Severe Absence - Autumn/Spring 2016-17 to 2021-22












Primary School Stacked Absence Data (Overall / PA / SA)
