
Visits To Places Of Worship

A visit to a place of worship, guided by a person of faith, really brings to life learning about the religion as well as being a unique, exciting trip for pupils and staff alike. Why not have a multi-faith day with visits to several places of worship to maximise the cost of travel, or combine a visit with a workshop? The price for a 1 hour session is £170, or if you are planning to book a number of visits, a contract provides even better value for money and starts at just £655 for 4 hours of tutor time. Visits can also be longer if that suits your needs better.

Virtual Option

If travel costs are proving a problem, we can also deliver virtually, i.e. a pre-recorded visit to a place of worship coupled with a live session with a tutor. We have numerous activities that we can deliver virtually, for example a question and answer session for older age groups or a related story to further enhance the experience for younger pupils.



Faith Trail Treasure Hunt

This is a fun chance for children to learn lots of facts about different faiths by participating in a guided treasure hunt around the district. The 2 hour session gives pupils a chance to spot artefacts and interesting items around the area. It could also be coupled with a visit to a place of worship, or a workshop, to maximise the trip and travel costs. Priced at just £109, this is a great experience and can be combined with other sessions, such as our workshops, to extend your pupils learning.

Workshops / RE Lessons

Assemblies

Our assemblies support schools to meet their statutory act of worship requirement by offering whole school or separate faith worship assemblies.

They are tailored to each school's requirements in content, length and frequency, and are excellent value at just £160.

We can also offer one-off special occasion assemblies - a great opportunity for pupils to share the celebration of their faith with their peers in a fun and educational way. These can be either in-person, virtual or a pre-recorded session.

Prices start at just £50 for the pre-recorded assemblies.

More In-School Options

Faith Carousel

This is a really cost-effective way for the whole school to learn about different faiths in an interactive way.

Tutors from your chosen faiths will come to the school and run individual stalls with artefacts, clothing, books etc. Students can chat to them, ask questions and handle the artefacts.

Young people often have many questions about faith and the world around them. This is an opportunity for them to ask those difficult questions in a safe learning environment.

Prices start at just £90 for a virtual session with 2 faith tutors, or £155 for an in-person session. However, the number of tutors and duration can be your choice, please ask for a bespoke price.



Staff Support

Scheduled training & e-learning

Our Getting to know Abrahamic or Indian Religions training provides a an excellent and affordable opportunity for staff to gain an insight into the key elements of the 6 major world faiths. The total price for both 1.5 hour sessions is only £85 per delegate.

For a specific faith, you can also access our e-learning modules on Skills 4 Bradford at just £48 per session which can be accessed and completed at a time to suit your staff.

Bespoke Training

This training is offered for whole school staff either virtually or in-school, to ensure all staff gain the same knowledge of all the faiths or specific faith-based topics.


