- Taught course involving 10 teaching days leading to a 60 credit level 7 certificate. These can be transferred to our MA courses in Education.
- Course specifically for Bradford SENCos. Possible options to gain additional qualifications and support for SEND and Autism available throughout the course via Chellow Heights. Based at Leeds Trinity University Campus with access to all University Facilities including the Andrew Kean Learning Centre.
- Focus on **SENCo as a practitioner** and **SENCo as a leader**.
