### Day 1:

An introduction to a five phase teaching sequence with quality texts at the heart. The training will be led by Philip Webb, supported by a Specialist Leader in Education (SLE)/Leader of Excellent Practice (LEP). It will cover engaging shared reading activities. It will show, in context, how texts can be used to support the teaching of text structure; punctuation and grammar. It will look at the planning, drafting, editing and publishing of writing.
