Ingredients

Your curry can be meat, fish or vegetable based. Best stick to the traditional rather than exotic meats though, as kangaroo curry may not appeal to anyone who has watched an episode of Skippy!



Homemade

It has to be home-made, perhaps a recipe that's been passed down through the generations in your family, or one that you've created yourself through your love of cooking. Tell us the story of where it's from.



WOW Factor

It's your favourite, but has it got the quality to impress the judges? Thankfully there are no scary auditions. So just let your recipe do the talking, and if you win you can visit our production kitchen and keep an eye on our chefs as they produce the winning dish.



Healthy

Is your entry a healthy dish?

It needs to taste great, and it would be best if you are able to keep the recipe as healthy as possible too.



Global

Your curry dish can be from, or influenced by the cuisine from anywhere in the world e.g from Thailand to Finland, from Malaysia to Mexico, from Pakistan to Poland, from Yemen to Yorkshire!!



Affordable

Another challenge is to ensure the dish is affordable, for anyone trying it at home, or the school cook (if it makes it onto the school menu), so keep an eye on the ingredient costs.

Recipe entries will be short listed, and the winning entrant will be presented with a certificate and a meal voucher for 4 people at a top restaurant in the district.
