All of the resources focus on the West Yorkshire Police priorities and Ofsted lines of enquiry and are linked to the DfE statutory guidance and PSHE Association Programme of Study to ensure we are best meeting the needs of our young people. Access to the resources remains free for every single school in West Yorkshire.

### Key changes for 2023/24 onwards:

- Lessons re-designed by PSHE specialists with content provided by West Yorkshire Police subject experts to maximise impact and usability.
- More focused in PSHE coverage, to address priority topics, such as sexual violence and harassment, child-on-child abuse and the perception that young people have of the police.
- All secondary lessons will have a flexible 20/40/60-minute delivery model to meet different curriculum models.
- A wider range of assessment opportunities so students can demonstrate their progress.
- Lessons built around values, skills, and attributes not just knowledge.
