



Developing Outstanding Middle Leaders Course

Facilitated by a NCTL trained Senior Leaders

This course focuses on developing middle leaders as outstanding leaders of teaching and learning, student progress and standards.

The key aims of the programme are to:

- Develop highly effective middle leaders, in order to improve pupil progress and raise standards.
- Develop a system in which leaders of today develop leaders of the future.
- Develop a learning culture in which middle leaders, and those aspiring to be middle leaders, learn with and from others resulting in increased leadership capacity.

The sessions provide guidance, challenge and support from experienced peers, expert input and facilitation to ensure high quality learning with a wide range of high quality resources.

There will be an intersessional task aimed at applying and consolidating new learning on leadership in order to have a positive impact in the home school context.
