Bradford Council has launched a new Learner Management System, **Learn and Develop with Bradford**. If you have Google Chrome installed on your computer you can access the site by typing the following into the address bar:

Parking advice when attending Margaret McMillan Towers

NCP Hall Ings Multi story carpark- Parking before 9.30am is £3.50 for all day. Parking here after this time is more expensive.

Broadway shopping Centre car park - This is a cheaper option at a fixed price of £3 all day, please allow more time for walking.

Sharp Street car park (behind Margaret McMillan) is 4 hours for about £3 and £3.60 for 5 hours, but spaces are limited.
