How many are hiding?

This activity is to support recall of number bonds facts for any number.

Each pair of children are given the target number of objects i.e. 5 (for number bonds of 5) and a cup / container.

The players take turns to 'hide' some of the objects in the cup. The other players then have to 'guess' how many are hidden using their knowledge of that numberbond.

Example for bonds of 5. How many are under the cup? We can see 3 so that means 2 are hidden as we have 5 altogether.
