Our pricing model consists of a fixed cost per type of school, in addition to a unit cost per pupil (as at the Autumn School Census).

For example, a Primary School with 400 pupils will be charged £700.00:

Fixed Cost: £500

Pupil Cost: 400 x £0.50 = £200

Deeper Data which has been updated and now allows you to analyse, interrogate and export end of Key Stage data and the ability to compare with other Bradford schools' outcomes for the whole school or vulnerable groups. Deeper Data allows you to filter in any combination: gender, PP, SEN reason & type, ethnicity, mobility, level of attendance, EAL etc.

The Data Dashboard bringing together a range of reports to help schools and officers. The reports include comparisons across all Bradford schools, LA level results and comparisons against the LA's Statistical Neighbours.

Key Data - the headline data for a school. It provides an important starting point when looking at your school's data as it includes, where available, Bradford and National averages for comparative purposes.

Perspective Lite providing early access to Early Years, Phonics, KS1 and KS2 analysis in June/July, which includes the emerging national averages.

Census Analysis spanning a 5 year period that is useful to demonstrate how the contextual makeup has changed over this period and in year. Comparisons can be made to other schools, the LA and Wards.



Pupil Results Finder allowing you to enter a UPN (or a block of UPNs) to get all available assessment outcomes and, if selected, associated contextual data. NB *This only works if the child has previously attended a Bradford school.*

Early access to data

We will ensure that EYFSP, Phonics, KS1 and KS2 analysis is available on BSO before the end of the summer term.

Secondary KS4 and KS5 analysis will be available once it has been released to us by the DfE in October.
