## School Responsibilities

Schools must ensure that all statutory returns to the Local Authority are accurate and submitted on time in accordance with the appropriate specification. The LA will work with schools to recommend any data quality improvements associated with data transferred to the central MIS and will look to the school to accommodate these where required.

In order to verify the accuracy of the process and also provide timely reports, the Information Management Team expects:

- KS2 Teacher Assessments to be submitted on time to the NCA Tools website
- EYFSP, Phonics and KS1 Teacher Assessments are submitted on time to the IMT Data Team
- Headline results from Secondary schools on Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5 results day to be submitted to the Information Management Team on time

Enter into an information sharing agreement for services to support the necessary exchange of data between schools and the Local Authority to enable the continued delivery of services to improve outcomes across Bradford, which are equitable, cohesive and meets the needs of pupils and young people.

Schools must not share or provide access to the information provided by Bradford Metropolitan District Council as part of this agreement to any individuals or organisations for commercial use.
