



KS1 and KS2 2015 results data for both attainment and progress now available – next steps for primary schools

The FFT Aspire dashboards provide you with the first full national analysis of your school's results for both attainment and progress (value added).

Quick and easy to understand, you can use your dashboard to identify whole school strengths and weaknesses as well as more detailed issues around pupil groups, subjects and even individual pupils.

By using the interactive dashboards, you can select from a wide range of performance and accountability measures to evaluate your 2015 performance. You can also gain an insight into how your school may perform under the new 2016 accountability, floor and coasting measures – choose KS2 Level 4B+ (attainment) and Average Point Score (progress) for the nearest approximate measures.

Next steps...

Step 1: Login to Aspire – www.fftaspire.org.uk

Step 2: Your basic analysis

Download your Governor Dashboard pdf directly from the Self Evaluation menu at the top of the screen. This is the first step to analysing your school performance in 2015.

Step 3: A more detailed analysis

Use the interactive Self Evaluation Summary dashboard in FFT Aspire to undertake a more detailed analysis. Select specific indicators, pupil groups and years to tailor the dashboard to your specific needs. Once you've made your selections, you can continue to work on screen or create your own personalised pdf dashboard for your school. Examples include:

- **3 year dashboard** (select Years 2013-2015) – very useful for ALL schools but in particular for SMALL schools and pupil groups.
- **SEN dashboard** (select SEN pupils only)
- **Gifted and Talented dashboard** (select High attainers only)
- **Pupil premium dashboard** (select FSM6 pupils only)
- **'2016' KS2 dashboard** (select L4B+ and APS indicators)

Step 4: Exploring further

Self evaluation dashboards are just one part of FFTAspire. They can be used in conjunction with the other dashboards included in FFTAspire:

- **Target Setting dashboard** – View benchmarks and set targets for all your pupils using the new 'Life after Levels' FFT bands. See how your school might perform in 2016 and beyond.
- **Student Explorer dashboard** – a term by term history for each pupil contained in a single dashboard including past attainment, progress, attendance, SEN FSM status and previous schools. Opportunities and Alerts indicators support early intervention and challenge.
- **Collaborate dashboard** – Analyse and compare your school's performance to other schools within your group. Aids school to school support and the sharing of best practice. Easy to set up and great for school clusters, multi academy trust analyses and any exiting networking groups.
