Your child's setting is accessing ongoing SEND Specialist Support from the Social, Communication, Interaction and Learning (SCIL) Team.

The support focuses on equipping settings to provide high quality support for children with Special Education Needs and Disabilities, through high quality teaching, reasonable adjustments and additional provision.

Over the coming months we will work alongside key staff in the setting to:

- share our specialist knowledge, skills and experience,
- develop inclusive practice of staff in the setting and,
- support the graduated approach.

Part of the support may involve conversations about your child or observations as part of the cohort with wider recommendations and support given to the setting around high quality teaching, provision, environmental adjustments and whole setting processes.

This may also include:

- Modeling the use of assessment tools,
- Modelling the implementation of strategies, resources, programmes or other intervention

We may record some personal information, such as a child's name and brief overview of their development, as part of our planning process. This enables us to tailor our SEND Specialist Support to meet the needs of the setting. **Any individual work or assessment would only be carried out with your consent.**
