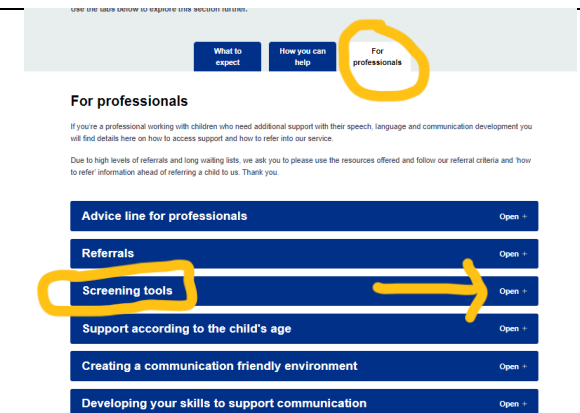




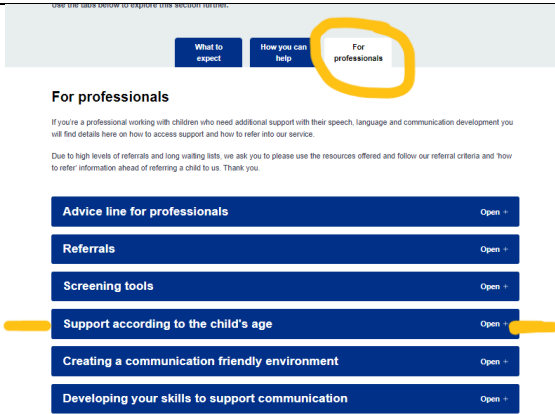
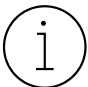

- Advice and videos for parents/staff/everyone:

You will see examples of published resources that you may already have in school to deliver targeted support for this area.</p>

Note- we now have separate forms for eating and drinking, stammering and communication. You can use the “multi-needs” form if you are referring for more than one area.
