Outline

Her Majesty's Inspectors are providing a series of face-to-face briefings for headteachers and chairs of governors in September 2017. The briefings will also include a question and answer session with the panel of presenters.

The briefings will cover any changes and planned changes to school inspection, inspecting governance and how inspectors establish the progress made by pupils who have special educational needs and/or disabilities.

Description

The panel will be made up of the following HMI:

John Young

John is a Senior Her Majesty's Inspector. He is a qualified teacher and has a master's degree in educational leadership and post-graduate diplomas in child development and psychology. John has huge experience of inspecting primary and secondary schools, local authorities, teacher education providers and pupil referral units. His particular areas of expertise are in evaluating leadership, teaching and pupils' achievement. Before joining Ofsted, John gained leadership experience as director of a specialist college, assistant headteacher and faculty leader. He was also an inclusion consultant to the Department for Education. John is responsible for the management of complaints against Ofsted and schools and for training and development for HMI in the North East, Yorkshire and Humber region.

Belita Scott

Belita is one of Her Majesty's Inspectors. Belita Scott has considerable leadership experience in education as a headteacher, a local authority school improvement partner and a member of the management committee of a school centred initial teacher training provider (SCITT). Belita's particular area of expertise is in school improvement, particularly in those schools facing the most challenging circumstances. She has post-graduate qualifications in international educational

leadership. Belita is Ofsted's national lead for governance.

Nicholas Whittaker

Nick is one of Her Majesty's Inspectors. He has over 25 years of teaching and leadership experience in secondary and special schools. Prior to joining Ofsted, he was the executive headteacher of two all-through special schools for children and young people with severe learning difficulties and complex needs. Nick also has experience as a senior local authority adviser and school improvement partner.
