



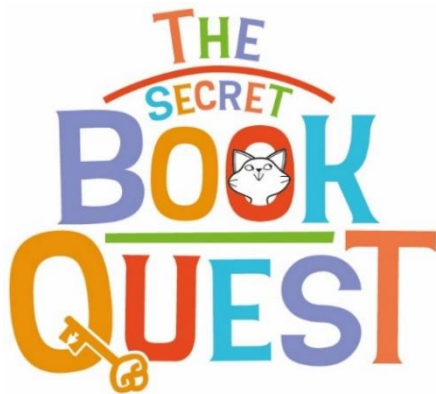
READING'S GREAT. PERHAPS MORE THAN YOU REALISED...
