Mathematics is a very important subject for the life chances of children. A good mathematics education is critical in developing problem solving and decision making skills. Leading maths in a school can be a challenging experience. We are still facing the fight against 'I can't do maths' and 'maths is hard'. This course is designed to support the new (and not so new) subject leader in developing and leading maths across the Primary school. The five half day sessions, complemented by gap tasks back in school, will include:
