Banner

Create a banner on fabric celebrating Bradford and your schools individual community and identity. We ask pieces measure approx. 5ft by 3ft but do not require poles. These can be painted onto fabric or be more elaborately woven or sewn pieces.

The content of the banner should display your school name and be a celebration of your school and your geographical area of the district

These banners will be displayed all around city square on the day of the event and will be available for schools to take back after the event

Laminated Art

Individual children can produce art that depicts and celebrates the culture and area of your school. Pieces should be on A3 landscape ways and laminated. Please attach all pieces together with treasury tags so they can also be hung from security barriers. Please ensure your school name is clearly displayed on one or all pieces. **Deadline: Tuesday 21 May 2019.**

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SOME IDEAS

The basic premise of this art project is to celebrate Bradford district as well as celebrate your school's own individual story.

- To do this staff and pupils need to think of striking visual images that link with the individual geographical location of your school and area
- Landmarks and history of your area
- What is your school particularly proud of, which sports, which areas of the arts?
- Does your school community have links with other places in the world?

Here are a few quick ideas but are they linked with your school?

- Bradford City Hall surrounded by fairies
- Five Rise Locks
- David Hockney looking on at your school and painting it
- Collage of famous musicians, actors, writers, composers, painters from the district
- The legend of the Bradford Boar
- Collage of famous landmarks of the district forming the shape of school children
- The legend of Rombald the Giant
- The Railway Children
- Steam trains
- The Bronte Sisters
- Sir Titus Salt
- Brass Bands

Remember the art work should be eye catching and individual.

You could base your artwork on one of the BBC's Ten Pieces or even combine this with a celebration of the district.

IDEA: Pupils create drawings of characters from Doctor Who (one of the Ten Pieces) and collage them around landmarks of the district.

Landscape paintings of the district with Tardis painted in areas.
