Christian is a British Army officer, currently holding the rank of Captain. He serves in the Adjutant General's Corps, Educational and Training Services Branch. His current role is that of Second in Command of 27 Army Education Centre Group, based in Edinburgh, and is responsible for managing and delivering training and education to soldiers and officers across Scotland.

Background Information

'Born and Bred' in Bradford, Christian attended St Bede's Grammar School, leaving school after completing his GCSEs in 2001. He did not continue onto A Levels as at that time he had "no intention of going to university", and instead completed a four-year Mechanical Engineering Apprenticeship. In 2007, at age 22 he decided it was time to

go to university, and attended Leeds Metropolitan to read History. During his time at Leeds he also studied abroad in Spain on the ERASMUS programme. He graduated with a BA(Hons) 2:1. Having gained the thirst for education, Christian then moved to London in 2010 to read for a Master's Degree at King's College London in International Conflict. He graduated with a Distinction in 2011, and in September of the same year commenced his military career, undertaking training at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst. He commissioned in Aug 2012 into the AGC (ETS). Since commissioning, he has completed a PGCE in adult education, a Certificate of English Language Training, and also a Master's Degree in Education and Innovation. He has served all over the UK, as well as deployments to the Falkland Islands, and Afghanistan. He is also a keen mountaineer, climber, and skier, all of which he has been able to pursue as part of his military service.
