### Raising the Participation Age

You may already know that the law is changing this summer, so that you must stay in education or training until at least your 18th birthday.

#### Your options include:

- full-time education, such as school or college
- work-based learning, such as an apprenticeship
- part-time education or training for young people that are employed, self-employed or volunteering for more than 20 hours a week.

It is important that you make plans for how you will progress post 16 to achieve your goals and make the most of your entitlement while your education is still free.

## Free taster sessions

We want to help you make the best possible choices about your post-16 education and training, and so we are organising a week of free taster courses where you can try out subjects and courses that might interest you.

In this booklet you will find a list of all the sessions that are being offered. You may attend up to **two** sessions, but please also give us a third choice in case your other choices are full.

This booklet does not include courses that your school will be offering to its own students only. Schools will arrange for you to find out about these internally. The sessions offered here are at places that you would transfer to at the end of Year 11, but you are welcome to try the tasters even if you think you are most likely to stay at your own school.

Several schools have Year 10 students out on work experience during the same week as Year 10 Choices. If you would like to attend the taster sessions during your work experience week, we hope you will be able to arrange that. It will be up to you to make those arrangements, but please make sure both your school and your employer know what you will be doing.

## How do I sign up?

1. You need to get an application form from your school. You will see posters up in school telling you which member of staff has these forms.
2. Fill in the form and sign it. It would be very helpful if you could give us a mobile number so that we can confirm your places and communicate with you by text.
3. We also need your address as most of our colleges will send bus tickets so you can get to the sessions free. The colleges do not have to do this, and your school is not obliged to provide transport, so you may have to pay for transport yourself.
4. Get a parent or carer to sign the form. By signing, they are giving their permission for you to attend the sessions.
5. Then get the named person at your school to sign it. This means they are giving you permission to go. They may refuse if they feel there is a good reason why you should not attend, and in that case you may not go.
6. Hand the form in at school and they will send it to a central point to be processed.
7. Applications close on **Wednesday 26 June 2013**.
8. You will hear from the colleges and other organisations you have applied to whether you have a place, and they will give you all the information you need.
9. For taster sessions that last all day the college will provide lunch, but for half day sessions they will not.
