These courses run by the National Science Learning Network have a course fee of £210 per day or £113 per half-day, and an Impact award of 70% of the course fee is generally available.

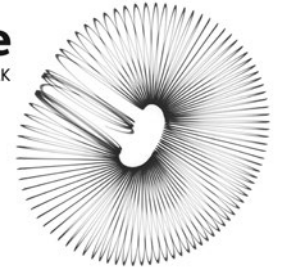
