Aims of the day

To provide an understanding of refugee integration for key services and staff and to provide an insight into some of the issues and challenges facing new refugees and those who work with them.

Aimed at:

- Managers, staff and volunteers responsible for both strategic and operational management;
- Frontline staff and volunteers delivering services in the community;
- Staff and volunteers who have limited knowledge on migration and refugees
- Anyone who wants an insight into the challenges facing refugees and how to respond to those challenges.

By the end of the course participants will:

- Understand the key differences between refugees, asylum seekers and other migrants.
- Gain knowledge of the experiences of refugees and asylum seekers and the reasons they seek protection.
- Understand the basics of the asylum system, refugee resettlement programmes and UASC.
- Understand the refugee 'move-on' period and the process of transitioning from asylum support to mainstream support.
- Understand the key challenges and barriers to refugee integration.
- Develop an awareness of the need for integration strategies to support and enable receiving communities and individual refugees to integrate better.
- Begin thinking about how service providers may respond to some of these challenges.
