We need 8372 football fanatics from the Bradford district to register themselves to play on Wednesday 12 July 2017.

The 8-3-7-2 football challenge will unite people across Britain playing football in memory of the 8372 men and boys who were killed in the Srebrenica genocide. In taking part, you will score a public victory against hatred and intolerance in the 22nd anniversary year of Srebrenica.

On 11th July 1995, 8372 Muslim men and boys were killed in Srebrenica – not in a terrorist attack but in a deliberate act of genocide against the Bosnian Muslim community.

We invite schools, youth groups & communities to participate by holding a football match or tournament on Wednesday 12th July to join thousands of others across the UK standing up to hatred and intolerance. All participating groups will receive free resources including the Remembering Srebrenica book, stickers for all participants and a short explanatory speech to be read out before kick-off. We ask that a minute's silence is held before the match to remember the victim of hatred.

Bradford Council would like to encourage as many schools and community groups as possible to arrange and take part in the football challenge.
