Education and Training for Primary Schools



Pedestrian Sessions

Year 1 and Year 2

Role Play Session

School hall, 30 minutes.

Key Messages: Holding hands, stop, look, listen, think, using the lollipop person and safer places to cross.

Year 3

Pedestrian Training – Practical on road skills

A teacher led classroom session (film and teacher notes provided), followed by one or two practical sessions a week apart. The practical training takes place on the streets surrounding the school.

Schools will need to provide at least one adult to help.

Key Messages:

Safer places to cross, parked cars and junctions.

In Car Safety Sessions

School hall, 30 minutes.

Key Messages:

Travelling in the car safely, using a seat belt and booster seat.



Year 4 and 5

Road Safety Quiz

School hall, 30 minutes.

An interactive 'quiz style' presentation.

Key Messages: Safer places to cross, becoming an independent road user, and the Green Cross Code.

Year 6

Charlie's Story

Classroom, 30 minutes.

Key Messages: Keeping safe as a pedestrian, distractions, consequences, and who is affected.

Parent/Carer Sessions

We offer advice and information for parents at coffee mornings, parents' evenings, toddler groups, school fairs, English as a second language classes and informally at the school gates.



Cycling Training

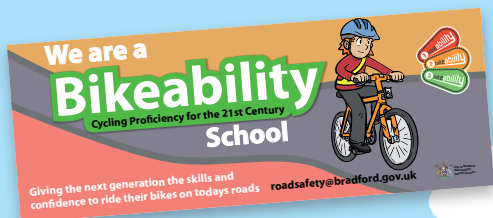
Year 5 and Year 6

Cycling Training

Off road skills based training for Year 5 and 6.

Schools are asked to provide the instructors, who may be teachers, parents, governors or volunteers.

The Road Safety Team will provide training and ongoing support for all instructors.



School Gate Parking Initiatives

Resources are available to help tackle parking problems outside the school gates. Parking banners are available on loan, leaflets for parents and a letter from the police can be supplied and assembly and lesson plans can be emailed. We can also offer support in setting up a Walking Bus or Park and Stride.

Year 5 and Year 6

Bikeability

Bikeability training provides the enhanced skills that children and young people need to ride safely on today's busy roads.

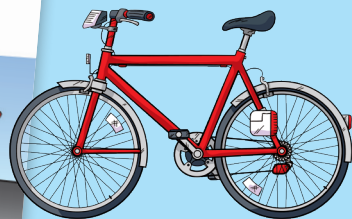
Level 1

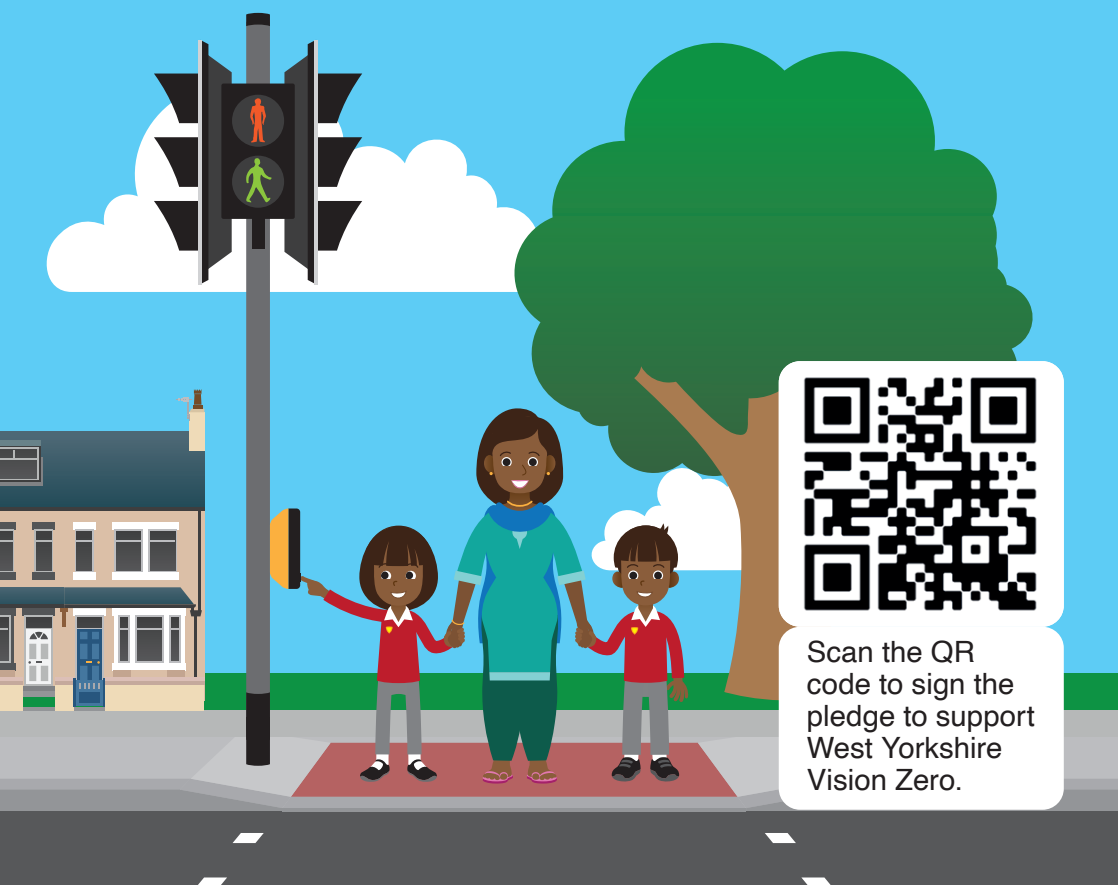
