Look and Listen. When there is no traffic near then walk straight across the road.


Stop. Stand on the pavement behind the kerb.

Think First. Find a safe place to cross then stop.


Wait until it is safe to cross. If traffic is coming let it pass.

b) How can they affect you as a passenger in the car?


## **Decisions and Consequences**
