Ingrow and Long Lee Federation (Keighley) have been allocated a small sum of money from the Local Authority to create a Safeguarding Centre of Excellence.

Like all schools, safeguarding has a high priority on our everyday agenda and it has been recognised that we have the capacity and potential to share our good practice with other schools in the local area. We are keen to share our strategies, learn from other settings and identify ways to support colleagues with the many varied challenges that safeguarding in school can bring. These may include:

- Sharing established safeguarding practices which have been externally verified through formal safeguarding reviews, feedback from other agencies and OFSTED. March 2017 -Ingrow February 2018 -Long Lee
- Supporting leaders to provide solutions and create action plans to address school audit needs.
- Providing skilled accredited staff to support the online safety curriculum and stakeholder training.
- Using our exemplary Social and Emotional, Mental Health Hub strategies (Silver Birch Hub) to find solutions to address the latest mental health agenda.
- Using alternative approaches such as Play Therapy to support access to learning.
- Working in partnership with the LA and BCSB.

We are planning a schedule of workshops, and bespoke packages, which will be subsidised for Bradford Schools. More information will be with you before the end of March.
