

The Wood Beneath the World is an immersive, interactive and visually stunning environment designed to inspire exploration, imagination and creativity.

For decades a mysterious wood has been growing silently underneath Leeds Town Hall, the roots and trees have burst through the floors and walls....now it has taken over. On the edge of the wood lives Jack, the keeper and tour guide and he is inviting pupils to come and discover and learn about the wood where together they must solve a number of tasks and riddles that lie within the trees.

Pupils will;

- Hear the story of The Wood Beneath the World and the characters that live there.
- Explore the woods and through storytelling and drama activities help Jack solve a number of tasks and riddles hidden in the trees.
- Play and create self-led journeys and adventures in the wood.

### WHO ARE THE WORKSHOPS FOR?

The workshops are designed for KS1+ KS2 pupils.

### WHERE DO THE WORKSHOPS TAKE PLACE?

All the workshop sessions will take place in The Crypt in Leeds Town Hall, all activity is fully accessible. The wood takes over an area of 270sqm.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

Each workshop is for one class (up to 35 pupils) and lasts for approx 1.5 hours.

The session will feature the character performing to the class, storytelling and drama activities.

There is also the opportunity for self-led sessions with no performer/ storyteller (please enquire for more information).

### THE SCHOOL NEEDS TO PROVIDE:

A class teacher will need to be present throughout the session

### WHAT WILL THE WORKSHOP COST?


Each 1.5 hour workshop session costs £6 per pupil with a minimum of 20 pupils (maximum 35). The Wood Beneath the World is available for a limited number of times/dates from Monday 17 November – Wednesday 17 December. We anticipate very high demand for the dates, so we advise that you book early.
