

1. Select Utilities and then Termly Attainment.




- 2. A list of the Children at your school who are Looked After by Bradford Council will appear. Select 'Manage Termly Attainment'.
- 3. Select the appropriate key stage, year group and term for the child/young person.
- 4. Enter the information as described overleaf.
- 5. Remember to click on the green update box to save.

Primary Schools - Early Years Foundation Stage

Select the appropriate year group and term.

Select each area of learning and from the dropdown menu please indicate if the child is 'emerging' or 'expected' for each are of learning.



Primary Schools – Key Stage 1

Select the appropriate year group and term.

Enter the data as indicated below.

Achieved

The achieved grades should show how the young person has performed this term for each subject. This is a teacher assessment, which should be informed by test data where relevant.

The phonics score should be added to this column after the child has taken the phonics screen check*.

Targets

This is an <u>End of Key Stage 1 Target</u>, informed by how the child performed at the end of Key Stage 1.

Targets should be set at the start of KS1 and remain unchanged to the end of KS1.

A phonics target is not required.

Prediction

The prediction indicates what the teacher predicts the child will achieve at the end of Key Stage 1. This may change from term to term as it reflects how the young person is currently performing.


A phonics prediction is not required.

On Track?

Is the young person 'on track' to meet their end of KS2 target? Yes or No should be selected for each subject.

The On Track box should be completed each term to show if the child is expected to achieve 32 (the most recent threshold the phonics screen check)*.

*Where a child meets the threshold for the phonics screen check in Year 1 this information is not required in Year 2.



Primary Schools – Key Stage 2

Select the appropriate year group and term.

Enter the data as indicated below.

Achieved

The achieved grades should show how the young person has performed this term for each subject. This is a teacher assessment, which should be informed by test data where relevant.

Targets

This is an <u>End of Key Stage 2 Target</u>, informed by how the child performed at the end of Key Stage 1.


Targets should be set at the start of KS2 and remain unchanged to the end of KS2.

Prediction

The prediction indicates what the teacher predicts the child will achieve at the end of Key Stage 2. This may change from term to term as it reflects how the young person is currently performing.

On Track?

Is the young person 'on track' to meet their end of KS2 target? Yes or No should be selected for each subject.



Secondary - Key Stages 3 and 4

Select the appropriate term.

Enter the data as indicated below.

Achieved

The achieved grades should show how the young person has performed this term for each subject. This is a teacher assessment, which should be informed by test data where relevant.

Targets

This is an End of Key Stage 4 Target, informed by how the child performed at the end of Key Stage 2.

Targets should be set at the start of KS3 and remain unchanged to the end of KS4.

Prediction

Predicted grades indicate what the child is predicted to achieve at the end of Key Stage 4. This may change from term to term as it reflects how the young person is currently performing.

On Track?

Is the young person 'on track' to meet their end of KS4 target - yes or no.
