Those pupils who pass the cycling test will receive a certificate and badge indicating they have learned the basics of safe cycling.

Please Note: This does not mean they are capable of riding safely on the road.

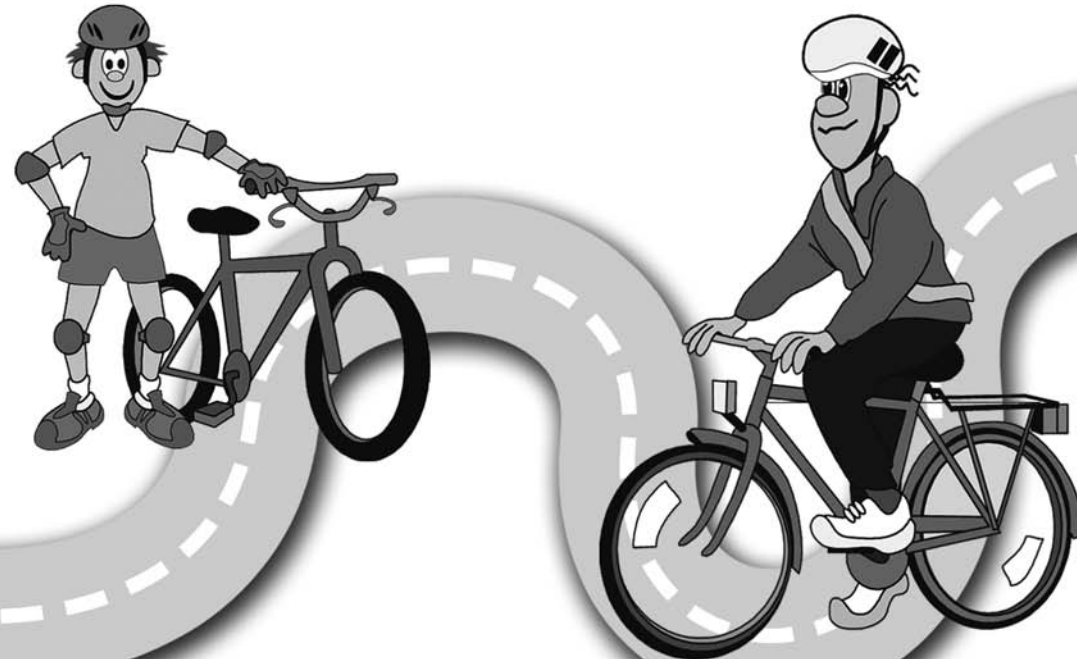

Cycling training scheme

For Year 5 & 6 Pupils

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The training

The skills are taught away from traffic, encouraging correct cycle control and road drills which cyclists will need to know when they do go out on the road.



The training covers:

- Basic Cycling Skills
- Simple Cycle Maintenance
- Knowledge of the Highway Code

Who can do the training?

Any school can apply to run a cycling training course. Schools are asked to provide the trainers, who may be teachers, parents, governors or volunteers.

The Road Safety Team will provide

Training and ongoing support for new instructors and for existing instructors who feel they would benefit.

How much training is required?

The recommended length of training time for cyclists is 6—8 hours.

Where will the training take place?

The training will take place on a road layout painted by the Road Safety Team in the school playground.

The test

There are six parts to the cycling test:

TEST 1 Highway Code Questions

TEST 2 Overtaking an Obstruction

TEST 3 Turning Right

TEST 4 Turning Left

TEST 5 Obstacles

TEST 6 Emergency Stop

To pass the test the cyclist must satisfy the examiner of their ability in each of the six sections of the test.



Maintenance Session

We offer a 30 minute classroom based cycle maintenance session. We require one bicycle to be brought into school for this session.
