St. Anne's school have a newly opened kindergarten/ Nursery with free places for children from 3 years old. Classes are held in small groups for children to receive the most help and attention from our teachers, Nursery Nurses and learning assistants. What takes place in the Good Shepherd Centre?

the Good Shepherd Center is open from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8.30 - 15.30.

The role of the Centre:

- Free English Literacy classes are held every Wednesday at 12.30-14.30 and Monday for the advanced group

Classes are taught by qualified teachers and cater for three ability levels: Elementary, intermediate and advanced (Which meet on a Monday). Parents with children are provided with child care in a creche during lessons.

- Every Friday we meet for 'coffee morning' and 'mothers and toddlers' where babies and toddlers attend play groups with a qualified kindergarten teacher. At the meetings our Health Visitor can weigh children, provide information relating to the health and development of children and offer general health care advice. There are always bilingual translators present and there is always a friendly, welcoming and cheerful atmosphere.
- We support families in many areas- resolving family issues, personal, physical and mental health support, financial, educational and spiritual.

- Every Thursday after school we run activities for children in the GSC. 15.30-16.30. It is SCHOLKA where we play sing and talk with children on a variety of interesting topics. SCHOLKA children also give performances in church and the locality

- If you want your child to be prepared for Baptism, First Holy Communion or Confirmation or if you or family members want to prepare for marriage in our Catholic church to please approach the Centre to apply.
